Provisional title for project: Online 'Dark Net' Drugs Markets: How Cryptomarkets Are Changing Two Years After the Closure of Silk Road

100 word abstract of what the project would probably undertake, and any data to be used

In September 2013, researchers scraped the contents of the drug cryptomarket *Silk Road* just weeks before the marketplace was shut by the FBI, creating the only existing snapshot of drug selling activities at its height. We have been scraping the contents of the many cryptomarkets that have come and gone since, and this 'big data' project has resulted in a dataset with over 100,000 listings for drugs and other illegal goods and services. The student will use a range of data coding and cleaning strategies (algorithms, traditional 'by hand' methods) and assist in the analysis of the data (specific topic to be decided). Any applicant with HTML/PHP coding skills may assist with scraping a new marketplace, but this is not essential.
