**100 word abstract of what the project would probably  
undertake, and any data to be used:**

Drug cryptomarkets – more popularly known as ‘darknet’ drug markets – have provided researchers and policy makers with unprecedented information about drug markets – the illegal drugs available for sale, their price, and the location of drug sellers. Because cryptomarkets allow researchers to estimate actual transactions and sales, we can also learn more about what drugs are being purchased by drug users, so filling in the ‘demand’ side of the puzzle too. This project will examine what we can learn from drug cryptomarket data by comparing results to those obtained from the Global Drug Survey – the largest non-population derived survey of drug users in the world. The comparison will allow us to learn more about the advantages and limitations of using drug cryptomarket data as a drug monitoring tool.
