Research questions:

Taking place in the run-up to, and in the aftermath of, the Scottish independence referendum in September 2014, this research aims to investigate the post-devolutionary relationship between Scottish nationalism and minority communities within Scotland. Thus, it will consider both the public, discursive constructions of Scottish nationalism with regard to ethnicity, as well as the interpretative and formative responses of minority communities to that nationalist project.
