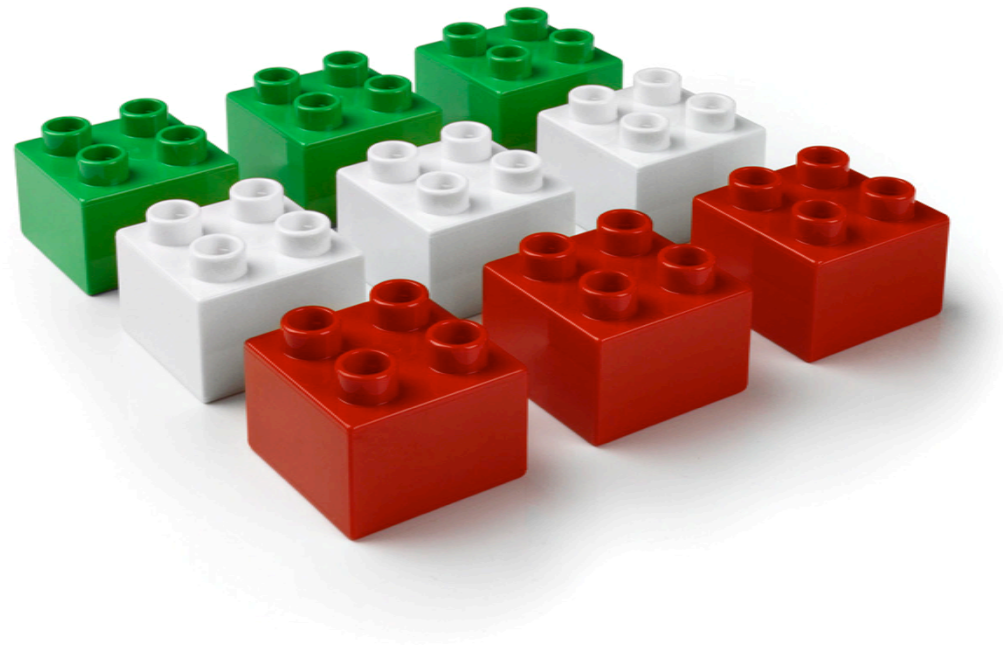

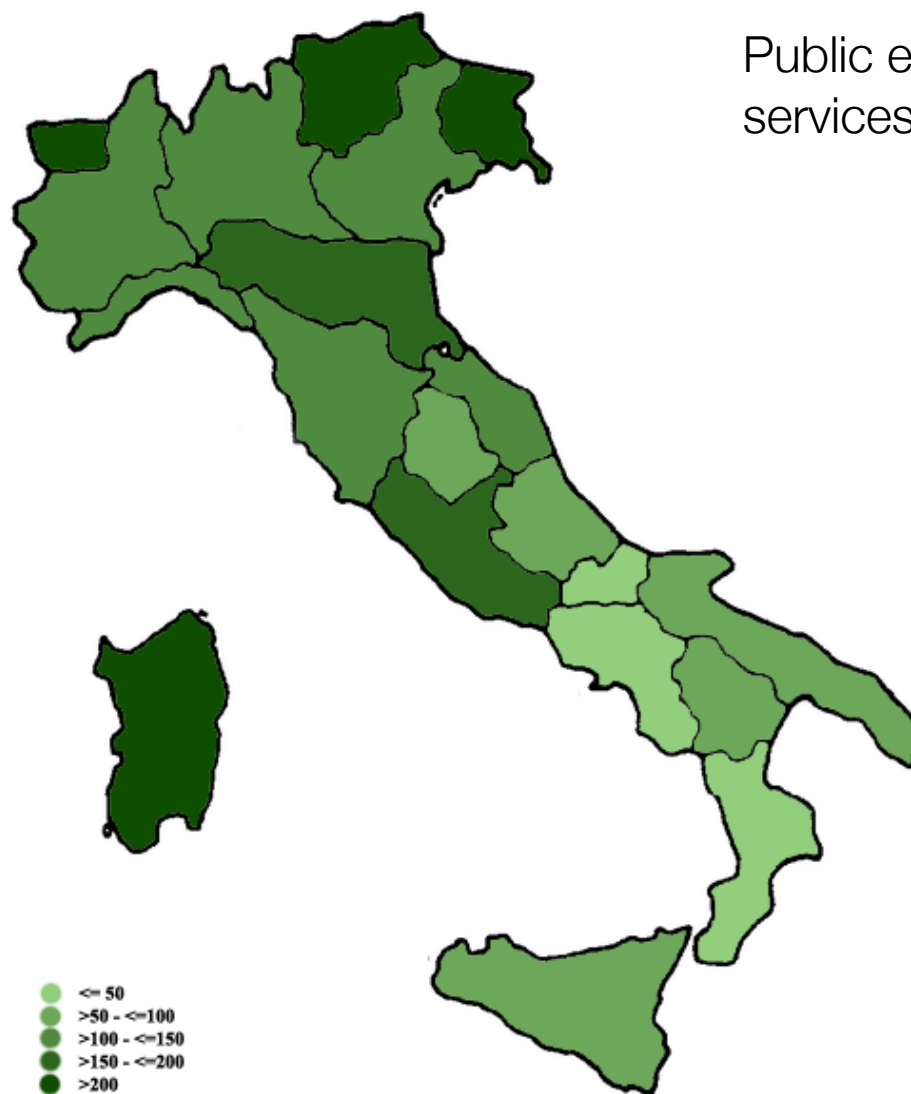

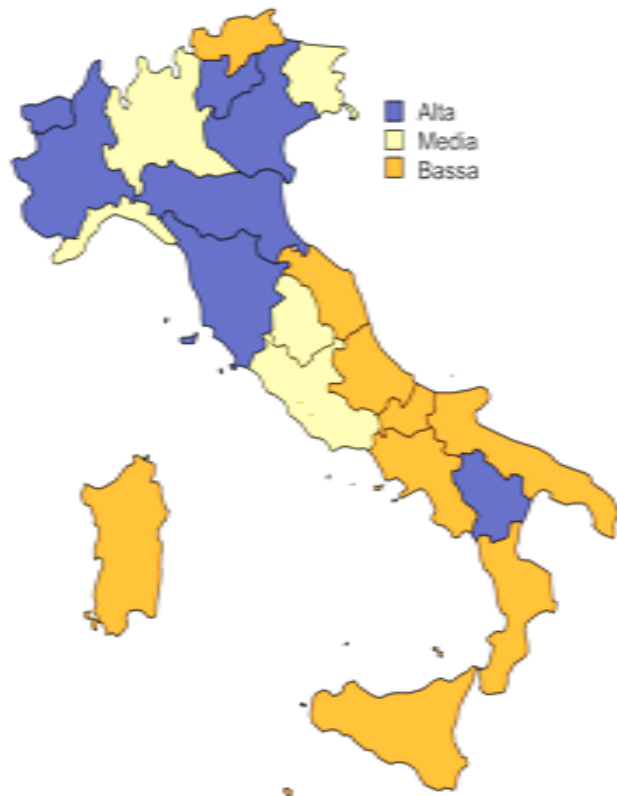


Public expenditure for social services per capita

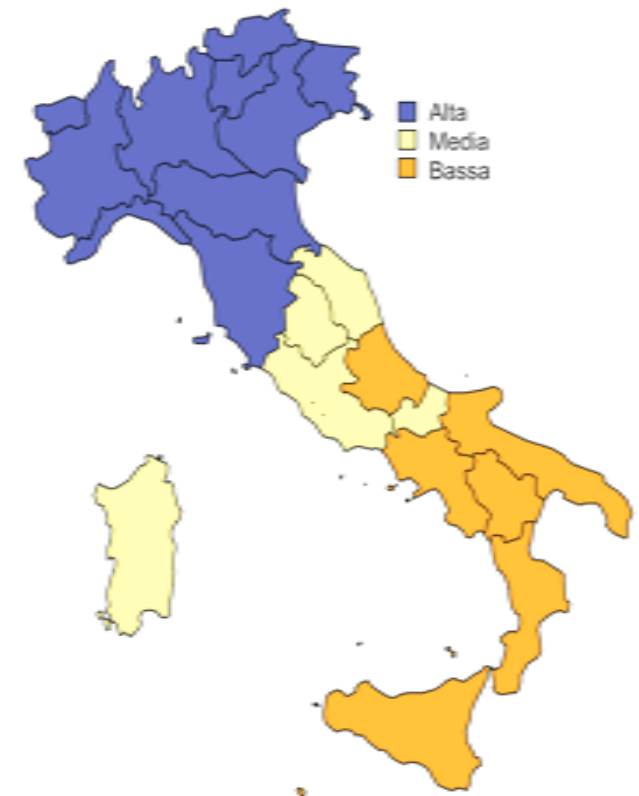
Appropriateness of hospitals



Efficacy of hospitals



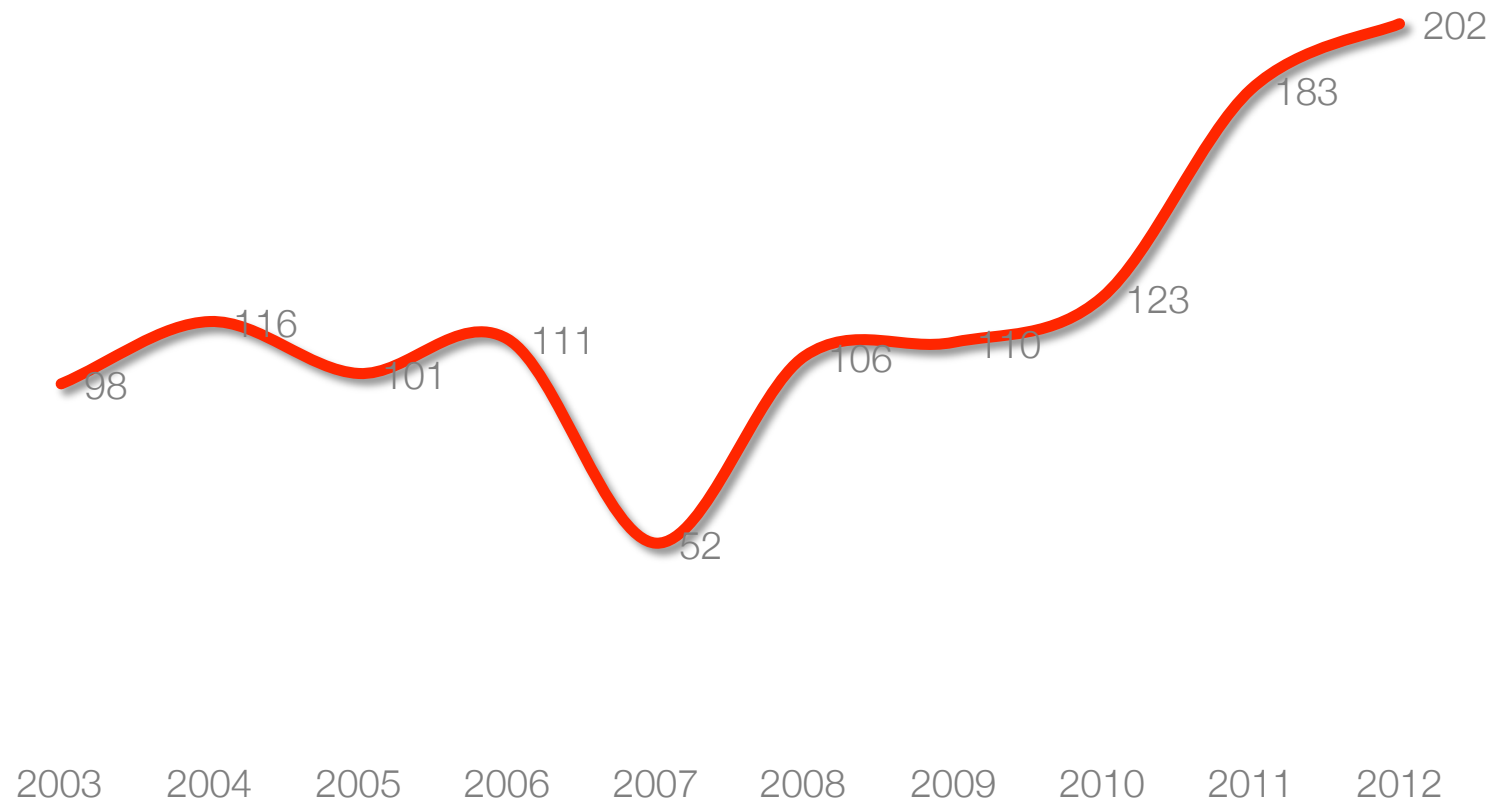
Satisfaction for health services



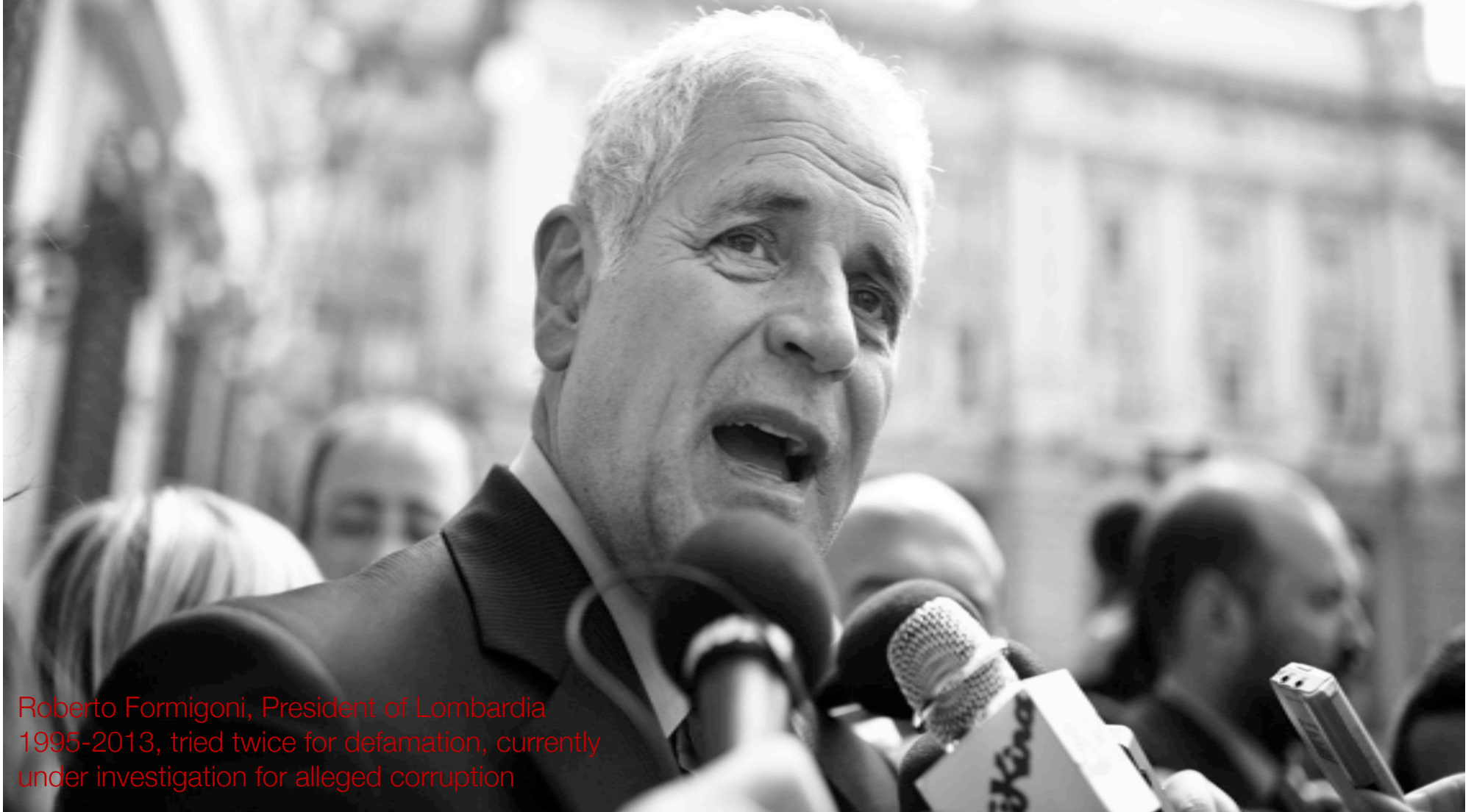
