#### **ROUTE 1**

The following documentation is required:

- 1) One document from Group 1 (see page 2) and
- 2) Two further documents from either Group 1, Group 2a or Group 2b (see pages 2-3)
- NB: At least one of the documents provided must show your current address
- NB: Original documents (not copies) must be provided

If you are able to supply all the required documentation through Route 1 (Points 1 and 2 above), then the document check is complete. If this is not the case, proceed to Route 2.

#### **ROUTE 2**

If you do not have any of the required documentation as listed in Route 1 above, you must provide three documents from Group 2 consisting of:

- 1) One document from Group 2a (see page 2) and
- 2) Two further documents from either Group 2a or Group 2b (see pages 2-3)
- NB: At least one of the documents provided must show your current address
- NB: Original documents (not copies) must be provided

If you are able to supply all the required documentation through Route 2 (Points 1 and 2 above), then the document check is complete. If this is not the case, proceed to Route 3.

#### **ROUTE 3**

Route 3 can only be used if it is impossible to provide the documentation listed in Routes 1 or 2 above, if this is the case you must, therefore, provide the following:

- 1) A birth certificate issued after the time of birth (UK and Channel Islands) and
- 2) One document from Group 2a (see page 2) and
- 3) Three further documents from Group 2a or Group 2b (see pages 2 and 3)
- NB: At least one of the documents provided must show your current address
- NB: Original documents (not copies) must be provided

If you are able to supply all the required documentation through Route 3 (Points 1-3 above), then the document check is complete. If this is not the case, you will need to be sent for fingerprinting by the Police which, you should be aware, is likely to cause a delay to the DBS application process.
