100 word abstract of what the project would probably undertake, and any data to be used:

Ambition for Ageing is a 4 year programme to reduce social isolation amongst older people by making communities more age-friendly. To ensure the programme also meets the needs of the most marginalised older people, the participating student will develop Ward Inequality Profiles using large national and local open data sets. S/he will collate relevant demographic data related to communities of identity and protected characteristics, produce data tables and diagrams, map data spatially using QGIS and provide written summaries of key findings. Data sources: ONS data files and indicators; local authority survey data

Ward inequality profiles, Demographics, Social isolation/deprivation, Older people, Spatial maps.

Essential and desirable skills that the student would need to have:

Essential:

Knowledge of ONS and other large-scale public data sets, especially indictors available through Neighbourhood Statistics. Ability to cross-tabulate, spot patterns and produce charts of different kinds to illustrate findings. Ability to create fluent commentary around the statistics.

Familiarity with QGIS software or similar spatial mapping tools
