- Changing lectures
- Rather than lecture, help prepare for class
- 2 In classes, rather than tell them stuff, ask them questions.

Potential Oh nos!

The chicken and the road



Complete thinking



- Pose a *problem*/data/policy and ask students to discuss.
- Monitor discussions, actively intervene.
- Seep on until a complete answer is provided.

Potential Oh nos!

Everyone gets it wrong, no discussion

Peer instruction



- Present a problem/data/policy and ask students to discuss
- Collect MCQ answers via TurningPoint
- If between 30% and 70% get the correct answer use peer instruction
- Re-collect answers via TurningPoint
- Repeat

Potential Oh nos!

Everyone gets it wrong, everyone gets it right, more wrong answers after discussion

Snap presentations





- Students are provided data/reading/evidence, eg macroeconomic indicators
- 4 Have 30 mins to prepare a 2 minute presentation for Newsnight
- A number of groups are randomly selected to give the presentation at the end
