Spaced-Out in the City

An Ambulatory Automatism in Search of Organization

Damian O'Doherty

This lecture reports on a methodological experiment that inscribed the letters 'order/disorder' across a standard A-Z map of Manchester. Deploying strict mathematical formulae in the spirit of the 'Oulipo' school a series of urban walks were designed in ways that might permit exploration and analysis of patterns of organization/disorganization.

Damian O'Doherty is Senior Lecturer in Organization Analysis at the Manchester Business School in the University of Manchester. He publishes widely across the social sciences and has recently co-authored the collection Manifestos for the Business School of Tomorrow published by Dvalin Press. Dr O'Doherty serves on the editorial boards of a number of journals and is executive board member of the Standing Conference on Organizational Symbolism.
