

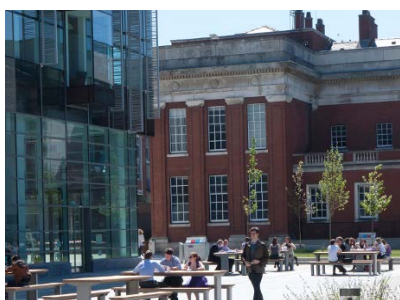
**School of Law
